Resources for Rural Minnesota

We realigned our work to meet current rural challenges, staying true to Mr. Blandin's vision.

Rural Grantmaking

In 2023, we awarded 73 grants totaling \$11.6 million to support sustainable, equitable futures in rural Minnesota.

- Community Wealth-building Grants: Helping communities retain knowledge and resources.
- Small Communities Grants: Providing funding, skills, and system changes to the smallest communities.
- Rural Placemaking Grants: Enhancing arts, culture, natural resources, and community pride.



Rural Capacity Building

- Scholarships: Funding education up to a bachelor's degree for students from Itasca County and surrounding areas. In 2023, we awarded \$1.5 million in scholarships to 354 local students.
- Community Relationships: Partnering with rural communities to provide resources and programming that foster collaboration and growth.



Rural Advocacy

The foundation amplifies rural voices in change-making conversations, advocating for those sidelined by outdated policies that no longer support rural Minnesota communities.
