


Once a month, a Chamber Member Business in good standing will be randomly selected during the monthly luncheon and featured for the upcoming month.




Northern Minnesota Swap Meet and Car Show Recap



Hooray for Another Successful Year at the Northern MN Swap Meet & Car Show! We are thrilled to announce the resounding success of this year's Northern MN












